Check and clean septic tanks. Your showers, toilets, sink drains and washing machines send a lot of water (and sludge) their way.



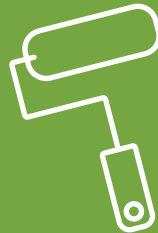
Steam clean carpets and couches, where applicable. You'd be surprised how much dirt and grime gets tracked in.
