Fireworks Safety

Seasonal Home Safety



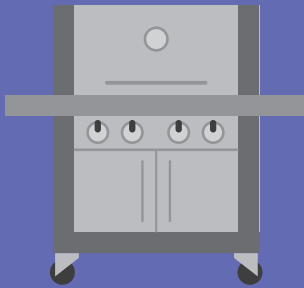
Put tools and garden equipment away at the end of the day.

Grill Safety



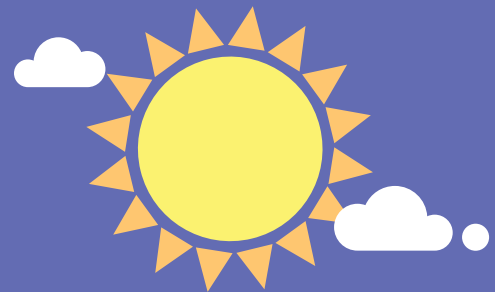
Use the grill at least 10 feet away from your house or any building.

Sun Safety



Use sunscreen 30 SPF or higher.

Drink more water.

Use an umbrella or overhang for shade.
